

Competition conditions of entry and entry form

Budding artists between the ages of 5 and 18 are invited to enter the Eurobodalla Council's Little Sellers Art Prize 2019.

The theme for the Little Sellers Art Prize is 'I can...'

Participants are encouraged to interpret the theme creatively in a way that is meaningful to them. There are four age categories:

- ages 5 - 8
- ages 9 - 12
- ages 13 - 15
- ages 16 - 18

Six finalists from each category will have their work framed and exhibited during the October school holidays, 2019.

The winner of each category will receive a \$50 voucher to artist supply shop Amanda's of Mogo. Each runner up will take home a \$30 voucher.

The overall winner of the Little Sellers Art Prize is acquisitive and will be chosen from the category winners. The winning entrant will receive \$200 from art collector, patron and philanthropist, Mr Basil Sellers.

In addition all entries will be in the running to win:

- the Eurobodalla Children's Award (for under 12's) of \$75 judged by Senior Coordinator Children's Services, Louise Hatton
- the Eurobodalla Youth Award of \$75 judged by Council's Community Development and Youth Coordinator, Zoe Morgan
- The three major prizes are acquisitive and will form part of Council's permanent collection

Conditions of entry

- only one artwork per entrant
- art work must be the original work of the entrant
- artwork must not exceed A3 in size. (42.0mm x 29.7mm) and can be vertical or horizontal
- artwork must be two dimensional and presented on reasonable quality paper so it can be framed for exhibition if selected as a finalist. Please do not use printer or similar paper
- artwork must be clearly labelled on the back with artist name, age, address, phone number, title of work and the direction the picture should be displayed, ensuring labelling is not visible from the front of your work
- entrants must allow all works to be reproduced by Eurobodalla Council in print and digital media formats for the purposes of advertising, promotion and documentation of arts and cultural activities occurring within the shire
- works can include digital drawings
- photographic work will not be accepted

How to Enter

- entry forms can be downloaded from the Eurobodalla Shire Council's website, or hard copies are available for collection from your local library and schools
- completed entry forms must include the title of the work and be signed by a parent or legal guardian
- artwork should be sent flat as it is not possible to frame artwork that has been rolled or folded. We suggest placing your artwork between two pieces of cardboard
- Council will take all due care of artworks submitted to the Little Sellers Art Prize but can take no responsibility for any loss or damage to artwork whilst in custody or transit
- Should you wish for your artwork to be returned to you, please enclose a stamped self-address envelope of an appropriate size
- entries can be submitted:

Judging

- six finalists will be chosen from each category and will be contacted in the week following the close of judging
- due to the expected number of entries, only finalists will be notified. If you are not contacted in the week after close of judging, your entry has not been successful this year
- entries will be judged on merit, originality and artistic interpretation of the theme 'I can...'
- chance plays no part in the selection of the winners
- one winner and one runner up will be chosen from the finalists of each category
- the winners of the Eurobodalla Children's and Eurobodalla Youth awards will be chosen from the finalists

- entries open Monday 11 March, 2019 at 8.30am
- entries close Friday 9 August, 2019 at 4.30pm
- judging period 12 - 16 August, 2019
- finalists notified 26 - 30 August, 2019
- winners announced Thursday 26 September, 2019 at 10am
- exhibition runs from Tuesday 1 October to Friday 11 October, 2019
