## Rabbit Calicivirus Release

RHDV (Rabbit Calicivirus) will be released for the purposes of controlling rabbits during the week beginning 21st May 2012 in the following areas:

- Tallawang Ave, Malua Bay

Two (2) free feeds (non-RHDV) will be distributed in these areas in the week beginning 21st May to determine uptake of the carrot baits prior to the release of RHDV.

RHDV is specific to European rabbits (i.e., does not replicate in dogs, cats, birds, fish, rodents or marsupials) and we highly recommend that pet rabbits be administered with a vaccine from your local vet prior to the 18th May 2012.
