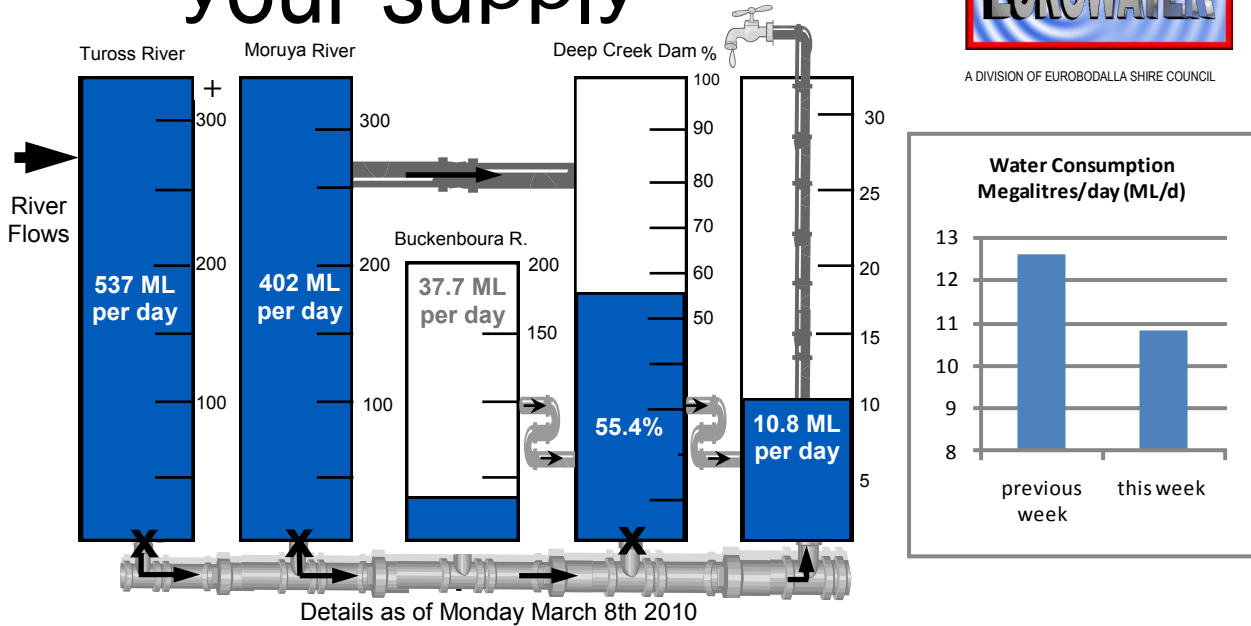

Water restrictions relaxed to Level 2

Thanks to all the rain, the rivers are now flowing like we haven't seen for some time, and Deep Creek Dam is filling faster than ever due to the operation of the new Moruya River to Deep Creek Dam pipeline. Due to this, Council has made the decision to relax water restrictions early, introducing Level 2 restrictions to ease the burden on the community. Under Level 2 restrictions, householders may now water gardens using a hand held hose or a drip irrigation system under the odds and evens system between the hours of 6-8am or 6-8pm. Sprinklers and unattended hoses are still banned. Whilst things are now looking promising for the water supply and it is hoped to have Deep Creek Dam full within the next 3 to 4 months, residents are still requested to ensure they comply with these restrictions unless prior exemption has been arranged, and to always save water whenever possible, as the less water we all use now, the sooner we will be able to fill the dam.
