- Congratulate Council and more specifically, Warren Sharpe and his staff for their work which resulted in a Clubs NSW Category 3 Grant of \$300000 for the all-inclusive playground at Corrigans Reserve.
- It is understood that Council will today consider a motion to appoint members to a joint working group to oversee implementation of this project. It has been my experience that six is the ideal maximum number to avoid talkfests and to promptly action items. Makeup is suggested:
 - The working group ideally should be restricted to a maximum of 6; Two from The Bay Push, 2 Councilors and 2 community members.
 - The \$100000 grant announced in December has an 18 month sunset clause and already the facilitators are seeking expenditure details.
 - Given that there will need to be design architecture, equipment selection including modification of existing equipment, Crown Lands approval and an extensive community consultation programme, time will be of the essence.
- Whist ultimately, it will rest with council to determine the council appointments, it is requested that those who have a special interest in the disability sector be included.
