- *Under the provisions of Section 26 of the Swimming Pools Act 1992, the applicant is entitled to appeal to the Land and Environment Court against the local authority within 28 days of refusal of the application; and*
- *The local authority's failure to determine the application within 6 weeks after it is made is taken, for the purposes of any such appeal, to be a refusal of the application.*
