PRESENTATION TO PUBLIC FORUM EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF COUNCIL TUESDAY 9 JUNE 2015

Thank you Councillors for the privilege of being able to address you this morning.

I am here to talk about the proposal in front of you today and I ask that you give this proposal favourable consideration.

This proposal strikes at the core of our democratic system of governance and processes that are in place to ensure that we act in accord with those principles such as fairness, equity and good governance.

It is a long bow to draw between a photo and DVD exhibition event and a small arms fair.

Question: Does an amendment to an event licence adequately address the range of issues that come with this change? More importantly, is Council and the community adequately protected by a change of this nature to the existing licence?

Independent advice would indicate that is not the case and this matter must be considered as a new development application because a small arms fair is a distinctly different activity from a photo exhibition event and requires a more fulsome review including a transparent and thorough community consultation.

To those councillors who are, or were, running on the ERA platform, you would appreciate your stated position of transparent and accountable local government. It is important that we also ensure councillors act on the best advice and in accord with durable, robust due process. The hallmark of good governance.

Question: What is the impact for Council of the event organisers denying access to our National broadcaster?
