



PRECINCT 1: NORTH STREET (Southern Side)

- Replace existing concrete pavement with brick and granite pavers
- Provide medium sized shade trees where possible
- Small alfresco and seating area with feature pavement and landscaping signifying entry threshold to core pedestrian area
- Potential for interpretive markers at western end of precinct





PRECINCT 2: NORTH ST & ORIENT ST INTERSECTION

- Reconfigured corner providing an attractive bookend to Orient St with prominent vegetation and canopy trees
- Significant meeting and rest point with raked concrete wall, long timber benches, and interpretive markers
- New 'at grade' unmarked pedestrian crossing across Orient St linking North Street with Bus Stop and 'Hub' area





PRECINCT 3: ORIENT STREET (NORTH)

- Pedestrian orientated precinct aligned with existing businesses requiring high shopfront exposure.
- Prominent vegetation and canopy trees, and upgraded brick and granite pavement.
- Reconfigured and increased angle parking bays, and relocated loading zone to bus stop area.
- New alfresco and public seating strip with landscaping, shade trees and furniture.

- Multipurpose Council and community 'pop up' structure.
- Central raised pedestrian crossing aligned to eastwest pedestrian thoroughfare through plaza.
- Southern 'at grade' unmarked pedestrian crossing with associated street furniture & landscaping to replace existing pedestrian crossing.



PRECINCT 4: ORIENT STREET (SOUTH)

- Streetscape configured for parking and driveway access to government agencies, motels, and clubs.
- New Beach Rd intersection granite pavement.

Landscaped strips with pavement, furniture, and interpretive totems signifying entry to core area on western side of street.



Planting and wall positioning do not impede traffic sight lines and deter 'jaywalking'.

Realigned line marking on northern corner reduces width of Clyde St and provides clear sight lines to new raised pedestrian crossing for vehicles tuning right from North St into Orient St.

- NORTHERN PEDESTRIAN CROSSING New 'at grade' unmarked pedestrian crossing across Orient St linking North St with Bus Stop & 'Hub' area.
- 6 ALFRESCO & SEATING STRIP New alfresco and public seating strip with landscaping, shade trees and furniture to replace existing parallel parking. Includes saw cut concrete pavement, accent strip pavers, furniture, interpretive markers, and landscaping. Loading zone relocated to bus stop, and 5min parking relocated to front of Post Office.

- New feature pavement, furniture, interpretive totems, & landscaping signifying entry to precinct.
- 11 BEACH ROAD INTERSECTION New granite pavement at intersection corner. Width of existing brick pavement reduced to accommodate planting bed and street trees along Orient Street.



- 6 ALFRESCO & SEATING STRIP New alfresco and public seating strip with landscaping, shade trees and furniture to replace existing parallel parking. Includes saw cut concrete pavement, accent strip pavers, furniture, interpretive markers, and landscaping. Loading zone relocated to bus stop, and 5min parking relocated to front of Post Office.

- 10 COURTHOUSE & POLICE ENTRY New feature pavement, furniture, interpretive totems, & landscaping signifying entry to precinct.
- 11 BEACH ROAD INTERSECTION New granite pavement at intersection corner. Width of existing brick pavement reduced to accommodate planting bed and street trees along Orient Street.


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
